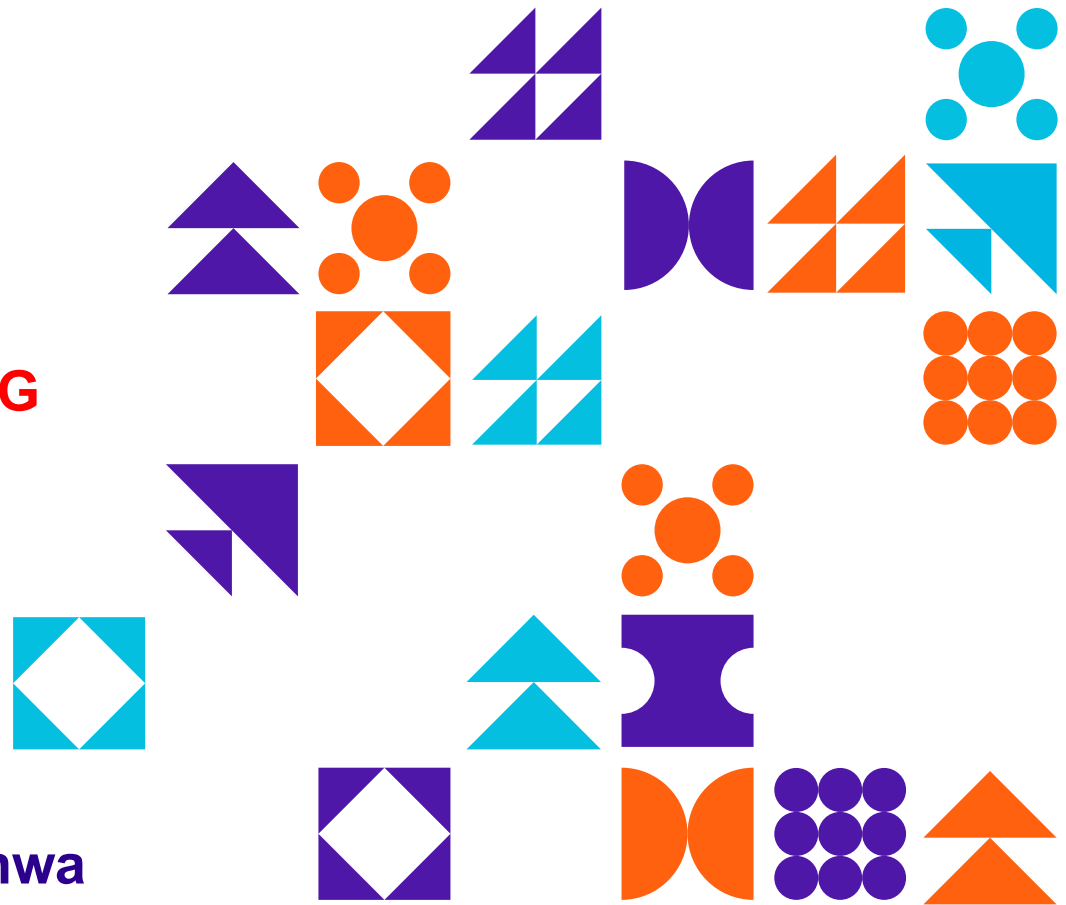

- Intensify Branch promotional support programs. **ONGOING**

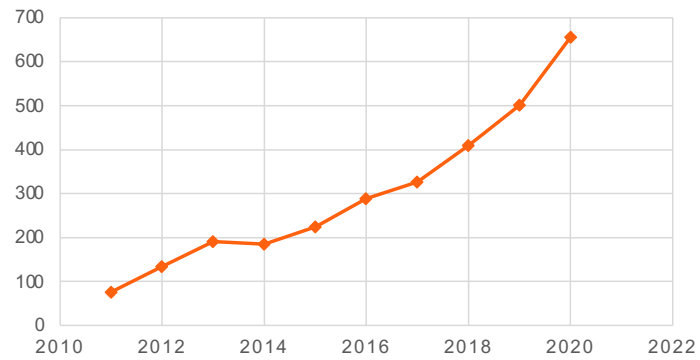

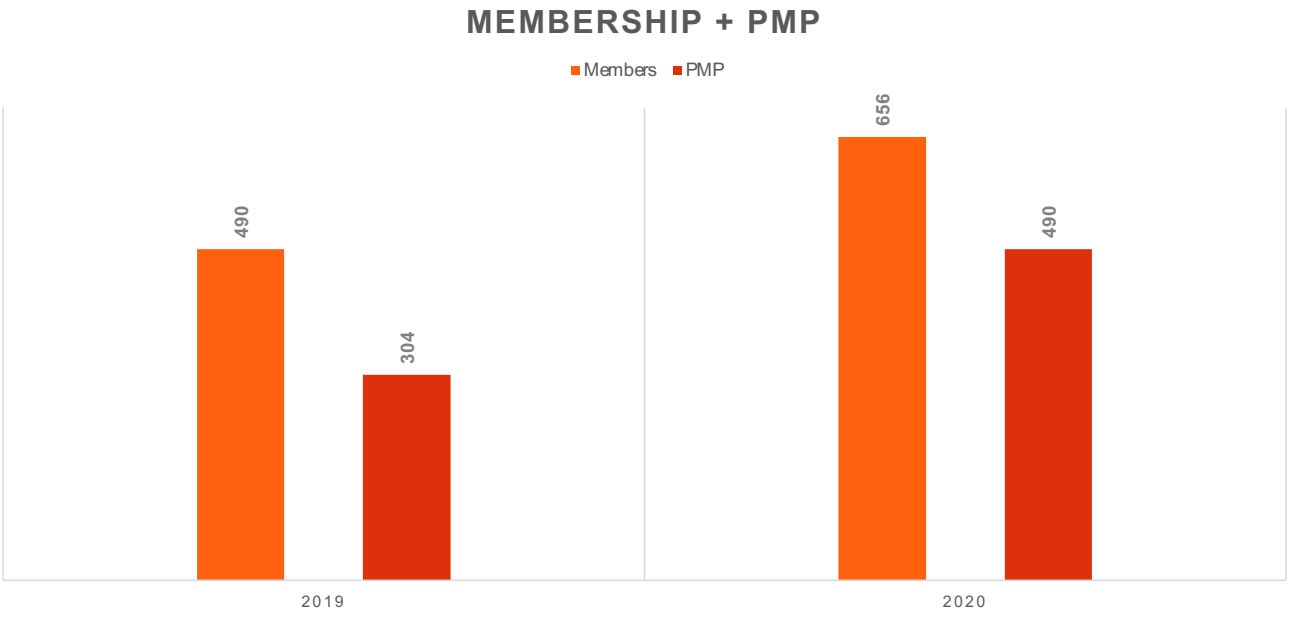

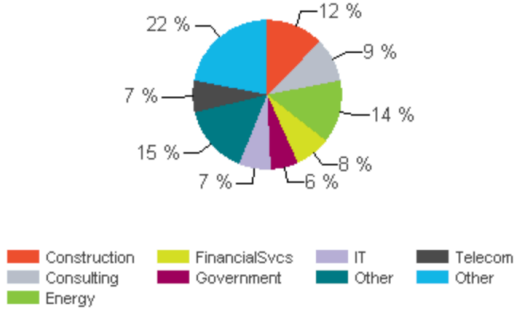

- Other logistical supports are encouraged



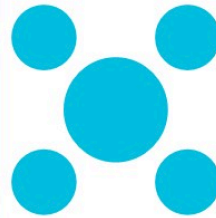
